What's the difference?

A commercial washing machine is designed for constant usage, large loads & built with specific quality components, tolerances, and features that you won't find in domestic machines.

There are several differences between a commercial washing machine and a domestic one. Broadly speaking, a commercial washing machine is built to withstand the intensive daily usage of a commercial environment.

Using inadequate equipment significantly increases the risk of breakage and downtime. In the long run, choosing the wrong machine will cost more than the initial investment needed for the appropriate commercial machine.
